Radiographic swallowing assessment if marked hypotonia, slow feeding, choking with feeds, recurrent or persistent respiratory sx, FTT

Eye exam for cataracts needed

Newborn hearing screen and follow-up

notes

CBC to rule out transient myeloproliferative disorder, polycythemia

TSH (may be part of newborn screening)

If myopathic signs or symptoms: obtain neutral position spine films and, if normal, obtain flexion and extension films and refer to pedi neurosurgeon or orthopedic surgeon with expertise in evaluating and treating atlanto-axial instability
