Plan and Follow-up Instructions- EPPA

- Concussion plan: Discussed at length with patient/family
 no red flags to indicate need for imaging at this time
 Need to promote cognitive and physical rest for the first few days after the injury.
 Avoid activities that provoke or make symptoms worse, especially activities that require eye tracking such as video games, texting, busy environments and school work
 once symptoms begin to improve, short periods of cognitive activity can be started, resting when symptoms worsen, then resuming when symptoms have lessened.
 Pt may return to school when able to tolerate cognitive activity at home, although he might not tolerate a full day
 ACE care plan completed and copy given to parent including recommendations for limiting activities requiring eye tracking (reading, taking notes), additional time for tests and assignments and breaks when needed.
 Discussed with parent and child that most students will be able to return to school within 1-2wk and advance to full academic schedule by 2-3wk
 Daily light activity such as a brisk walk is encouraged as long as symptoms aren't worsened.
 once patient is tolerating a full day of school without symptoms, a full academic work load and is caught up in school, he may start the stepwise return-to-play protocol as described
 When patient can tolerate school, begin with light jogging and gradually increase physical activity.
 At any time if increase in symptoms, go back to lower level to achieve pain-free
 avoid over the counter pain meds
 may use melatonin 3-6mg as needed for sleeplessness
 School note written with accommodations as needed
 will reevaluate in office in 5-7d
 reviewed risks of return to activity too soon and of recurrent concussions
 will refer to concussion clinic for further evaluation and/follow up if symptoms persist or not improving over 3-4wk
