- ☐ Acne instructions: Reviewed etiology and expected course with patient and parent

reviewed facial cleansing once daily with mild cleanser or water

may use nutrogena acne face wash once daily

avoid oils to face

sleep with hair off of face

reviewed myths re: acne and foods eaten

reviewed topical application of meds ordered, pea sized amt to cover entire face

reviewed side effects of erythema, dryness, sun sensitivity, bleaching of clothing and how to manage/prevent all of above

will start with every 2nd-3rd day application and gradually increase as tolerated to instructed use

reviewed indications for and recommended duration of tx of po meds

Discussed expected course of improvement with results not expected to be noted for at least 6-8w

will reevaluate if no improvement at that time

- ☐ Eczema: Pt to bathe daily for 5-10min in lukewarm water with mild soap such as dove or non-soap cleanser cetaphil

Pat dry and apply lotion/emollient within 3min

May use ointments such as aquaphor or eucerin during low humidity seasons (winter) and lotions such as cetaphil restoraderm or cera-ve during higher humidity summer season.

avoid harsh laundry detergents, dryer sheets, irritant clothing (wool)

Reviewed low incidence of food allergies as etiology for eczema outside of infancy. Use topical steroids as

prescribed for flares. Apply to rough and red areas only, twice daily until improved then an additional 3-5d to prevent re-flare. If recurrent symptoms may use twice weekly during high risk season to prevent flare

When using moisturizers along with medications, the moisturizer should be applied about one hour after applying the medication. When not using additional medications the moisturizer can be continued twice daily for maintenance.

RTO with worsening symptoms or if not improving over next 3-5d

- ☐ Poison ivy dermatitis instructions reviewed: Reviewed plant dermatitis with pt and parent

Reviewed topical care including 1% HCT for itching.

may use benedryl po for itch

avoid topical benedryl due to sensitization

may use aveeno anti itch lotion or topical calamine

Reviewed lesions are not contagious and cannot spread to pt or others

Reviewed prevention of recurrences including avoidance, ivy block and immediate washing after being in high risk areas

- ☐ Urticaria: discussed possible etiology, most commonly viral; reviewed any new exposures; discussed that in most cases etiology is not identified. Keep skin cool, since hives are worse when warm. May use benedryl by mouth for symptomatic relief of itching. May use aveeno/oatmeal baths for relief or itch. Avoid topical benedryl since this might worsen hives. Hives might take 3-5 days to resolve. Go to ER with any difficulty breathing or oral/airway swelling

- ☐ Warts plan and instruction: Discussed pathophysiology of warts
Discussed options for treatment including observation, OTC medications and cryotherapy.
